Dear Parents/Guardians,

Once again, we find ourselves in the situation where we are required to move from face-to-face teaching to remote learning.

We are aware that disruption to schooling could impact children's opportunities and affect health and wellbeing. However, we must keep everybody safe and the action is necessary in achieving this. Pastoral support is available to children during the lockdown and if you are concerned about your child's health and wellbeing or believe they could benefit from counselling please contact Mrs McGinn.

Our Remote Learning days in Term 1 have helped us ensure we are in a very positive position to move forward with remote learning for our students. These are challenging times for all and taking account of individual home circumstances we have put together the following remote learning models to facilitate the continuity of learning.

Guidance for Continuity of Learning

Key Stage 3

The KS3 timetable sets out the days on which your child will be set work by their subject teachers in Key Stage 3.

Teachers will assign work for their subjects on these days only. If work is assigned earlier, students can choose to complete the activities on the set day, or at a time that best suits their home circumstances.

Key Stage 4 & 5

You may be aware of media reports that GCSE and A level exams are pending cancellation. We do yet know what alternative awarding arrangements will be put in place. We will keep you updated as we receive more information.

We expect that pupils will continue to complete work so that they are best prepared for the next stage on their educational journey.

Teachers will aim to assign all KS4/5 work on Teams at the start of the week to allow students to organise a weekly schedule to complete their learning. Teachers will continue to connect with students through Teams throughout the week to monitor completion of work and offer support if, and when needed.

All Students

Students should aim to complete the learning and the assignments by the date set by their subject teacher, or as close to the date as possible.

We encourage you as parents/guardians to support your child's learning by helping them to organise their daily activities and complete the learning to the best of their ability. The times set out on the suggested timetable for KS3 are to help students structure their learning; teachers will aim to respond to queries in a timely fashion.

To continue to deliver high quality learning experiences to all our students, only significant pieces of work will be assessed throughout this period of remote learning. Feedback will vary from subject to subject to suit the nature of the learning experience and support the continuity of learning.

Student engagement will be closely monitored by subject teachers. If the College has any concerns regarding engagement, we will be in touch.
